Time is running out...

There are only about ten days remaining if you would like to contribute to this year's **Wreaths Across America** program. We need to get the wreaths ordered and paid for in time to be delivered from Maine for the ceremony on December 13th. **To do so, we need to receive your order and payment no later than Friday, November 21st.**

The cost of a wreath is \$15.00. The transportation and delivery is donated to the program by participating trucking companies. Wreaths will be delivered to all National Cemeteries across the nation. Arlington National Cemetery is one of the most popularly recognized and volunteers plan to place 235,000 wreaths there on December 13th. It is important to know that **all proceeds are used to buy wreaths**. This is not a fund-raiser.

Your contribution will buy wreaths for placement at the Marietta Confederate Cemetery located at the east end of the Marietta City Cemetery, 381 Powder Springs St. Marietta. It is one of the largest Confederate cemeteries and the resting place to over 3000 soldiers from every confederate state plus Maryland, Missouri and Kentucky. In 2013 we placed over 400 wreaths and hope to do considerably more this year. We hope you will attend and participate. The ceremony is conducted at all participating cemeteries at **noon on Saturday, December 13th**. Due to limited parking it is best to arrive by 11:30.



Wreath placement is a good experience for your entire family. Youngsters will learn about the war and grow with the experience of honoring the fallen.

It is not necessary to purchase a wreath. There will be more than enough for all who wish to participate in wreath placement.
